

Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997

Notice of Proposed Special Event

Notice is hereby given that Belfast City Council by virtue of the powers conferred on it by Article 8A of and Schedule 3A to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 is minded to make an Order to temporarily restrict or prohibit all traffic from using the following roads in accordance with the details in the Schedule hereto to facilitate the safe operation of filming organised by **Robert Huffam**. Where necessary, local diversions will be in operation, signed as appropriate during the times stated below or until the time the event is announced by the organiser as completed, whichever is the earlier, the right of way on the road, vehicles and other forms of traffic shall be restricted or prohibited.

Monday 12 May 2025 and Tuesday 13 May, 6am to 4pm.

- Closure of Linenhall Street (from Howard Street to Ormeau Avenue).
- Closure of Donegall Square Mews (from Adelaide Street to Linenhall Street).
- Closure of James Street South (from Linenhall Street to Bedford Street).
- Closure of Franklin Street (from Adelaide Street to Bedford Street).
- Traffic Control on Clarence Street.

Tuesday 13 May 2025, 12noon to 7pm and Wednesday 14 May, 8.30am to 5pm.

- Closure of Mount Eden Park (from Malone Road to Malone Hill Park).
- Closure of Malone Court (from Mount Eden Park to Oakwood Park).

Thursday 15 May 2025, 1pm to 5.30pm.

- Traffic Control on Massey Avenue (from a point 90m east of Belmont Road to junction of Castlehill Road).

Thursday 15 May 2025, 9.30am to 6pm.

- Closure of Cyprus Avenue.
